For example, Assignment 1 could be the Introduction & Methods of a report, and Assignment 2 the full report, including Results and Discussion. It is essential that these details are negotiated at the start of the course and outlined in the Learning Contract. Completed and signed copies of the Learning Contract are held by the Administration Office, the Course Coordinator and the student.

Students must submit all assignments to obtain a passing grade.
