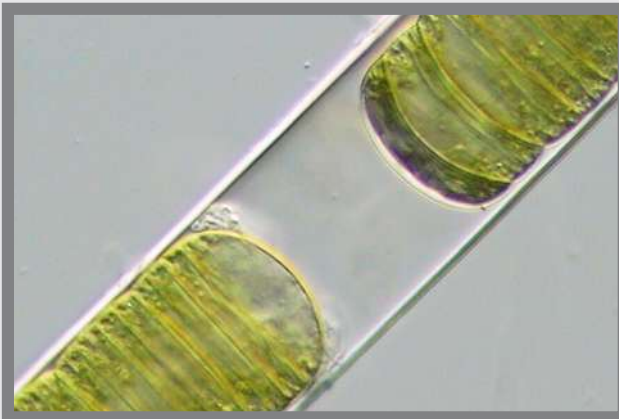

They can also form harmful algal blooms impacting aquatic health.
